## Keynote speakers



**Rosemarie Nagel**

Rosemarie Nagel is ICREA Research Professor of Economics, director of BESlab at Universitat Pompeu Fabra, and research professor at Barcelona GSE. Her research, in experimental and neuroeconomics, builds bridges between economic theory and human behavior by structuring bounded rationality using game theory, psychology, laboratory- and field experiments, and neuroscientific tools. Currently, she is working on (behavioral) structures of games. She co-organizes workshops and summer schools on experimental and macro-, and computational economics. Her approaches are applied in micro and macroeconomics, finance, neuroeconomics, management, psychology, and computer science.



**Ariell Reshef**

Ariell Reshef is a CNRS Researcher (Directeur de Recherche) at the Centre d'Économie de la Sorbonne, Université Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne, and is an Associate Member of the Paris School of Economics. His research interests focus on income distribution – in particular, the relationship of labour markets with global trade, technological change, regulation, and with the long run evolution of the financial sector. His work lies at the intersection of international trade, labour economics, and macroeconomics, and it studies changes in human capital, skills, and wages.



**Uta Schönberg**

Uta Schönberg is Professor of Economics at University College London. Her research interests are in applied microeconomics, in particular labor economics. Topics she is currently working on include: the role of firms in the rise of wage inequality and the impact of business taxation on local labor markets, firms and workers. She is currently a Joint Managing Editor at the Review of Economic Studies. In 2019, she received a 5-year ERC Consolidator Grant from the European Research Council for her project "Wage inequality within and across firms: the role of market forces, government and firm policies".
